



# Transitional Care Integration Meeting

## Meeting Summary, February 27, 2018

### I. Welcome and Introductions

Christina Mitchell welcomed the work group participants and facilitated introductions. Christina introduced Alexandra Toney. Alexandra joined the CHOICE team as a program manager and will be taking over the Transitional Care work group. Christina reviewed the agenda for the meeting:

### II. Project Scores and Funding Distribution

Christina announced that all nine ACHs received a 100% score for project scoring. CPAA ranked second highest on the initial submission.

CPAA will receive two different types of funding, DSRIP and IGT. We anticipate receiving the DSRIP funds in March and the IGT funds in May. CHOICE has sent out an instruction letter explaining the registration process for the payment portal. CHOICE is still finalizing the distribution model. Note: Registration for the payment portal does not guarantee payment.

### III. Updated Pay for Reporting Measures

First year funding was based on planning in 2017. Funding for 2018 will be earned by meeting milestones outlined in the tool kit.

Next year CPAA will earn money primarily through pay for reporting metrics which are still in development by HCA. Some examples of P4R metrics for years 3-5 are listed below:

- Practice/clinic site is actively sharing information (via HIE) to coordinate care
- Providers are trained on project selected evidence-based approach(es)
- Providers who are trained actively implementing evidence-based approach(es)



- Medicaid Providers are defined as clinic/practice sites who provide physical and behavioral health services paid by Medicaid.

#### **Community Based and Social Organizations All Projects - Examples**

- Organization site is actively sharing information (via HIE) to coordinate care
- Organization staff trained on project selected evidence-based approach(es)
- Organization staff implementation of project selected evidence-based approach(es)

These metrics are still in draft form.

## **IV. Capacity Assessment**

An instruction letter was emailed to CHOICE partners informing them on the upcoming survey that will be distributed March 5<sup>th</sup> 2018. The survey will be available online at [www.cpaawa.org](http://www.cpaawa.org) and will be available until March 26<sup>th</sup>. This survey will help identify gaps, assets, and what assistance providers are requesting.

## **V. Transportation**

CHOICE is working with Health Care Authority to begin conversations about ways of improving our current transportation system based on concerns discussed in the February work group. HCA responded and is open to addressing current issues. Work group members were open to a representative from HCA attending the March work group meeting. Transportation concerns were also discussed with the Consumer Advisory Committee in February and reviewed with the work group. Consumers stated they do not like to use Medicaid transportation, and prefer the bus system. Concerns with the bus system include perceived rudeness, damage to wheelchairs, and no access to urgent care services after hours.

## **Domain 1 Investment**

Christina brought up the desire to deepen the conversation about Domain Investment. CPAA year one and IGT funds will soon be available. Christina opened up the conversation to see specifically how we can help our region right now. Some of the topics that were covered are listed below.
