### I. Executive Summary & Next Steps

- The next meeting will be on January 29, 2018 from 9:00-10:30am.

- CHOICE and CPAA hired a new CEO, Jean Clark. She will begin December 10<sup>th</sup>.
- Change Plans were submitted on October 15<sup>th</sup> for review by CPAA. They were returned with feedback on November 1<sup>st</sup> and a final draft was submitted November 15<sup>th</sup>.
- The final draft will be approved by December 15<sup>th</sup> and will trigger a release of funds as partners' first deliverable.
- CPAA is beginning a value-based payment awareness campaign to share resources, educational materials, and VBP tools with partner organizations.
- CPAA will host a webinar in January to talk about the metrics data platform. More information will be provided later.
- In 2019, the workgroup structure will transition into a learning collaborative structure.

### II. Project 2A Updates:

- Hours are still available for the Psychiatric consultant that CPAA contracted with. The cost of consultation is free for partners. Please email Kyle Roesler if you are interested.
- Two training cohorts are currently going through the AIMS Center Whole Person Care Training. The AIMS Caseload Tracker is also available to partners free of charge. Two cohorts began in the fall, and two more will begin this winter.

### III. Learning Collaborative:

- In 2019, the workgroup will shift more to a learning collaborative. The goal is to emphasize peer learning, shared experiences, focus on evidence based practice, and plan for sustainability. There will be an expectation that partners who are involved participate and come prepared to the meetings.
